The Beatitudes (Matthew 5)

Our sixth beatitude says, "Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall see God".

How can our spiritual hearts be pure?

Vs. 3. First we must realize our spiritual poverty, (we are sinners).

Vs. 4. We should mourn over our poverty and confess to Christ, (repent).

Vs. 5, We should grow in our relationship with Christ and stand on God's Word, (meek).

Vs. 6, Our faith in Christ and our growing in His Word has done something for us that the world could never do - satisfy us, (filled us). Vs. 7, Because God's mercy and grace in our lives has been experienced, we can now show mercy unto others, (merciful).

Jeremiah 17:9, "The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately wicked, who can know it?" In salvation, the Lord Jesus offers the opportunity to become a new man, to experience a new mind, and to receive a changed heart! Only Jesus can impute righteousness and purity into the believer's heart where sin once resided. Only through believing in His death, burial and resurrection for our sin and allowing Him to empower us with a new life can the heart experience the purity that pleases God.

Christ, and Christ alone, has met the greatest need we ever had when He took out the corrupt heart and gave us a heart that desires God and longs for a greater intimacy with Him.
